- 1. Abstract submission is open to Senior Residents (SR)/trainees in Adult and Paediatric Nephrology and medical students in Southeast Asia countries.
- 2. Accepted research abstracts may be assigned for either oral presentation or poster presentation.
- 3. A total of 8 abstracts will be selected for oral presentation on 13th Oct 2024 at 0830- 1030 hours during the Singapore Society of Nephrology (SSN) 14th Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM).
- 4. Entries received after the closing date will not be considered.
- 5. We invite entries for 2 categories: Basic Science Research and Clinical Research.
- 6. Each author may submit only 1 abstract for this meeting.
- Abstract presented previously in local, regional or international meetings as either oral or poster presentation may also be submitted. Only abstracts that were or to be presented during the period of 14th Sep 2023 till 13th Oct 2024 will be eligible for consideration.
- SSN will email notifications to the Corresponding Author and Submitters by 2359 hours on 18th August 2024. It is the responsibility of the Corresponding Author to share the notification with their co-authors.
- 9. Travel grants may be offered to overseas participants with abstracts acceptance. This is based on first-come-first- serve basis. Recipients must attend the conference in person and present their abstracts (oral or poster) to qualify. Please contact the SSN Secretariat at <u>secretariat@ssn.org.sg</u> for more information.
- 10. The best oral presentation will receive a cash prize sponsored by the Chapter of Renal Physicians
- 11. The organisers reserve the rights to withdraw oral presentations from a category if insufficient entries or entries of inadequate merit are received.
- 12. The judges' decision is final.

Format of Abstract and Submission

- 1. Word limit of 300 words (excluding title, authors and institutions)
- 2. The suggested format of abstract is shown in the subsequent page.

Poster Preparation Instructions

- 1. The poster board surface will be about 2m high x 1m wide (Max). Your poster must fit within this space. An A0 size poster (841 mm x 1189 mm) will be sufficient.
- 2. Include the abstract title and all authors at the top of your poster.
- 3. The title lettering should not be less than a 48-point type. The body lettering should not be less than a 24-point type.
- 4. Your poster should be readable from a 1-meter distance or more.
- 5. Your poster should be self-explanatory so that you are free to supplement the information and discuss particular points raised by viewers during your presentation period.
